Boating and fishing on Wimple Pond, bottle rockets (either bring yours from last year, or if you're new to Tuscola camping make your own launcher), Traditional Cub Camp favorites; shooting range, archery, crafts and games as well as earning advancement. It can all be yours at the Tuscola Cub Day camp. Pitch your tent and spend Friday night out under the stars, or come just for the festivities on Saturday.

Registration fee of \$40 covers all activity fees Friday evening and all day Saturday; light dinner Friday night, breakfast, lunch and snacks on Saturday and supplies. Meal tickets for parents and leaders are \$10.00. Packs provide their own tents and overnight Lion and Tiger campers must be accompanied by an adult or guardian. For groups coming as a Pack there must be two-deep leadership and one adult for every 6 Cubs. Individual campers who are not signing up with a Pack group must have an attending parent or guardian. Parts A and B of the BSA annual health exam are required for all participants (youth and adults) and should be turned in with your advance registration.
