Pre-requisites: All participants must be current in Youth Protection Training.

All participants must complete Sea Scout Adult Leader Basic Training. SSALBT is

available on-line in the Learning Center of <my.scouting.org>.

Other Scouters must complete their program's required position training.

All participants must submit a current Annual Health and Medical Record, form 680-001 (parts A and B). Anyone with serious medical concerns should also include part C.

Registration: Seabadge is open to all registered adult Scouters, not just Sea Scouters.

Registered youth (19-years and older) may also participate in Seabadge.
