UPDATED POLICY on BOY SCOUT SUMMER CAMP FEES for ADULTS

Current Policy from the 2016 Lantern, Camp Drake Leader Guide

ADULT LEADER FEES (page 2)

In following the national Boy Scouts of America Youth Protection Guidelines, all troops attending summer camp must have at least two adults present at all times. One leader must be at least 21 years of age, and all additional leaders must be at least 18 years of age. Adult registration fees, including late fees are due according to the same schedule as the youth fees.

The fees for adults who accompany a troop are as follows:

1- 8 boys – 1 adult free 9-16 boys – 2 adults free 17-24 boys – 3 adults free 25-32 boys – 4 adults free
 Additional adult leaders = \$130.00 each

For troops of 25 or larger, continue this sequence to calculate leader fees required.

To meet two deep leadership requirements at camp, your troop has several options:

1. Troop provides all adults. Rotation of leaders is acceptable as long as two adults are present in camp at all times.
2. Two troops may share a campsite and therefore share leaders.
3. One provisional leader (at least 18 years of age) can be hired from the camp staff at a nightly rate of \$10.00 per Scout in camp. For a troop with five Scouts, this will total \$50.00 per night. Arrangements must be made with the Camp Director, no later than May 1st for June sessions and June 1st for July sessions. The provisional leader will only provide overnight supervision in the campsite.

All adult leaders attending camp must submit a current completed medical form to camp personnel.

Parents, friends, and relatives are invited to visit program areas while camp is in session. All visitors must check in at the camp office. Meal tickets MAY be available for guests in the dining hall during the week, however there is a limit to how many persons can be seated and fed per meal. Tickets are sold in the trading post on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations for guests can be made by emailing CampDrakeKitchen@gmail.com, and getting a confirming email back that there is room for your group. For the evening campfire programs, guests may bring lawn chairs for added comfort.

Updated Information regarding the Adult Leader Fees on 2/5/16

PLEASE submit all camp fee payments with a completed 2016 Camp Drake ATTENDANCE TRANSMITTAL FORM

ADULT LEADER FEES for the full time volunteers attending the week of summer camp with their troop is due along with the Scouts registration fees on Friday, April 15, 2016. Adult Leader fees not paid by this date will be subject to the same \$15.00 late fee as the youth participants.

VISITOR'S MEALS are defined as a ONE TIME, ONE MEAL only ticket for parents, family members, and guests. The Visitor's Meal Tickets will be sold at the Camp Drake Trading Post for \$6.00 per meal, based on availability of space in the Dining Hall. Visitor's meal tickets may be reserved prior to attendance at Camp Drake by e-mail to CampDrakeKitchen@gmail.com.

For the Scouting supporters who fall in-between these two categories, a PART TIME VOLUNTEER "Day Plan" is available. This "Day Plan" fee needs to be paid like Adult Registration fees on the troop level, through the Raymond lee Service center, using the Attendance Transmittal Form to designate the participation timing. The "Day Plan" will cost \$30.00 per card. A Day Plan card will be good for 3 meals, to be used as needed by the card bearer throughout the camp week. The "Day Plan" cards must be purchased by Friday, June 3, 2016. Any adult leaders attending Camp Drake overnight must submit a current medical form.
