Changes Coming in 2014 for renting the Camp Drake Kitchen

To bring us more in line with state laws regarding food service, and to ensure cleanliness and orderliness to the Camp Drake Kitchen, there are some changes coming on 1 February 2014. More detail will be available closer to that date, but here are the highlights:

- The kitchen may only be used when there is running hot and cold water.
- Any group wishing to use the kitchen must reserve the space at least 30 days in advance, and discuss the rental with the Assistant Camp Director prior to use.
- At least one person from the group renting the kitchen must be certified in Food Service Sanitation by the Illinois Department of Public Health.
- At least one person from the group renting the kitchen must be trained through the council to use the kitchen. Training sessions will be held at no charge during council events such as OA weekends and during summer camp.
- Deposits will be held for up to 30 days after the rental of the kitchen to allow time for an inspection to ensure that all items used are properly put away, and to identify any items that were used that will result in a charge to the group using the kitchen.

The goal is to educate a broader number of people in our council to use the great facility we have while ensuring that the facility is cleaned, maintained, and stocked for the next group interested in renting it.
