- 1. Make sure that all registered leaders have completed the new online BSA Youth Protection Training. This training is mandatory for the protection of our youth members AND our registered leaders. It only takes about an hour. New Leaders cannot be registered without completing Youth Protection Training. All leaders must take the New Youth Protection Training immediately. Any leader who is camping with a unit needs to be registered and have Youth Protection!
- 2. Position specific is available in several ways including on site unit training by your District Training Committee. Contact your Senior District Executive to arrange for a training team to come to your unit and get everyone prepared to run a top notch Scouting program.
- 3. Outdoor training for leaders is available through the Council Training Committee at Camp Drake. Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO) and Outdoor Leader Skills Training for Boy Scout leaders will all be held the weekend of October 27-28.
